WHEN IS IT?? It begins at **9:00 am SATURDAY, SEPT. 25** and ends by **9:00 am on SUNDAY, SEPT. 26.**

WHERE WILL IT BE HELD? Camp Ma-Kee-Ya in Harriman State Park, owned and operated by the Ridgewood, NJ YWCA. We have electricity, running water & cabins for sleeping, as well as access to a lake, playing fields, woods and buildings so that the retreat can go on **rain or shine**. WHO WILL BE THERE?? Youth and adults come from all over Metro District. The retreat is staffed and run by YRUU high school members, with RE teachers and parents attending as additional staff and advisors. The youth-adult ratio is about 5:1.

COST: \$60 per attendee. This covers food, lodging, and other expenses. We regret having to charge Adult advisors, and hope that your congregations can reimburse you. If the fee presents too large an obstacle for attendees or advisors, please contact us

WHAT TO BRING:

NORMAL STUFF LIKE: toothbrush, toothpaste, towels, soap, comb, etc., **sleeping bag, sleeping pad, pillow, blanket**, change of clothes, flashlight, **raingear, WARM clothes** for evenings, sturdy shoes or sneakers (*Hint: a sleeping pad will make the bunks more comfortable.*) Don't forget your **adventurous spirit**. Please **DON'T** bring food to the cabins. We don't want to attract our animal friends.
