- What:** Fifteen hours of Our Whole Lives Training for Junior and Senior High Leaders
- Who:** This is for Leaders who want to facilitate OWL for young adults and adults. DREs, RE Chairs and Ministers are also welcome. Registration is limited, so sign up early!!
- When:** November 7-9, 2008. Friday 7pm to Sunday 3pm. Full participation is required for certification as an OWL Leader. Avoid the Friday afternoon rush hour traffic and come early in the day. Dinner will be available at 5:30, so come early and relax before we start. **We must start on time!**
