### Just the Facts

- What:** Fifteen hours of Our Whole Lives Training for Junior and Senior High Leaders – the Basic Curriculum plus the UU Faith Supplement
- Who:** This is for Leaders who want to facilitate OWL Junior and Senior High Grade youth. DREs, RE Chairs and Ministers are also welcome. Registration is limited, so sign up early!!
- When:** August 5-7, 2011. Friday 7pm to Sunday 3pm. Full participation is required for certification as an OWL Leader. Avoid the Friday afternoon “shore” traffic and come early in the day. There’s a swimming pool and dinner will be available at 5:30, so come early and relax before we start. **We must start on time!**
- Where:** Murray Grove Conference Center - near to the place where Universalist John Murray landed.
