

## **UU Congregation of Monmouth County Studies Global Warming**

As an outgrowth of its Study Action Group on Global Warming, the Green Sanctuary Committee of the UU Congregation of Monmouth County (Lincroft NY) has begun interfaith work for environmental stewardship. Jointly with St. Mary's Catholic Church, the Congregation is co-sponsoring a free, non-technical talk on global warming, on April 2, 2006, at 4 p.m. A question and answer period follows the lecture titled "Our Changing Climate" by Anthony J. Broccoli, presently Director of the Center for Environmental Prediction and the Graduate School of Atmospheric Science at Rutgers University. Broccoli moved to Rutgers after 21 years at the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's Geophysical Fluid Dynamics Laboratory in Princeton, one of the premier climate modeling centers in the world.

The Statement of Conscience on Global Warming will be presented at General Assembly in June 2006; this lecture will provide a background for consideration of this serious topic in our "interdependent web."
