

## The UU Justice Ministry Application

**Deadline: July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010**

The UUJM is currently accepting applications on a rolling basis between now and July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010.

### How to Apply:

The application process involves a written indication of interest and short essays and a follow-up interview either over the telephone or Skype.

The written portion of the application should include: a letter of interest, a 1-page resume, two optional references (while the references are not a required portion of the application, preference will be given to those which include them).

Your cover letter should address the following questions:

- Unitarian Universalism has a long history of social justice activism. How do you understand your faith as supporting your vision for social change?
- The UUJM Fellowship is a year-long commitment beginning in September. How will this fit into your life? How are you able to make this commitment at this point in time?
- In addition to helping us create and staff a drop-in center for day laborers, you will be participating in theological reflection and faith-based organizing. Tell us why you want to learn or deepen your understanding of Unitarian Universalism
- Communal living can be rewarding and it can be difficult. Why do you want to live in an intentionally Unitarian Universalist setting? What will you bring to this house?
- At least in our first year, we will charge \$500 a month in rent (utilities included). You will be expected to volunteer 15 hours a week in our drop in center and help develop regular evening programming. It is likely that you will need to have at least a part-time job. How will you manage your service commitments and your need to support yourself financially?
- Tell us what you hope to learn from this experience.
