



What's old is new again in Jamesport, NY!

The North Fork Unitarian Universalist Fellowship (NFUUF) holds weekly services at the Jamesport Meeting House, located near the beautiful vineyards on the East End of Long Island on Route 25 and is the oldest structure in the town of Riverhead. Built in 1731, this historic building was recently purchased by the Jamesport Meeting House Trust (JMHT), a coalition of people from NFUUF and the local community. The trust has been undertaking very important restoration work of the building and grounds. The space has also been used to benefit the community, including drama troops and musical performances.
