

ADVANCED Youth Advisor Training

What: Fifteen hours of training for Youth Advisors and interested persons. We also expect this to be an outstanding opportunity for networking and mutual support among Advisors.

The Advanced Youth Advisor Training for adults (AT2, 15 hours) is designed for advisors seeking to certification as a UUA Certified Advisor. This training discusses more serious issues in youth advising, youth ministry, church staffing and structure, adolescent issues, and other relevant topics. It is our hope that this will become the prerequisite training for paid youth program directors & coordinators, as well as the model for future seminary courses on Ministry with Youth.

Who: This is aimed at Youth Advisors who have been advisors for a year or more, though we welcome new advisors who feel the need to get some training NOW! DREs, RE Leaders, and Ministers are also welcome. A small number of district youth (≥ 18) will be joining us. Registration is limited, so sign up early!!

When: January 20-22, 2006

We will begin PROMPTLY at 7pm on Friday, January 20, and continue until noon on Sunday, January 22. Saturday will begin early and end late, to allow for 15 hours of training.
